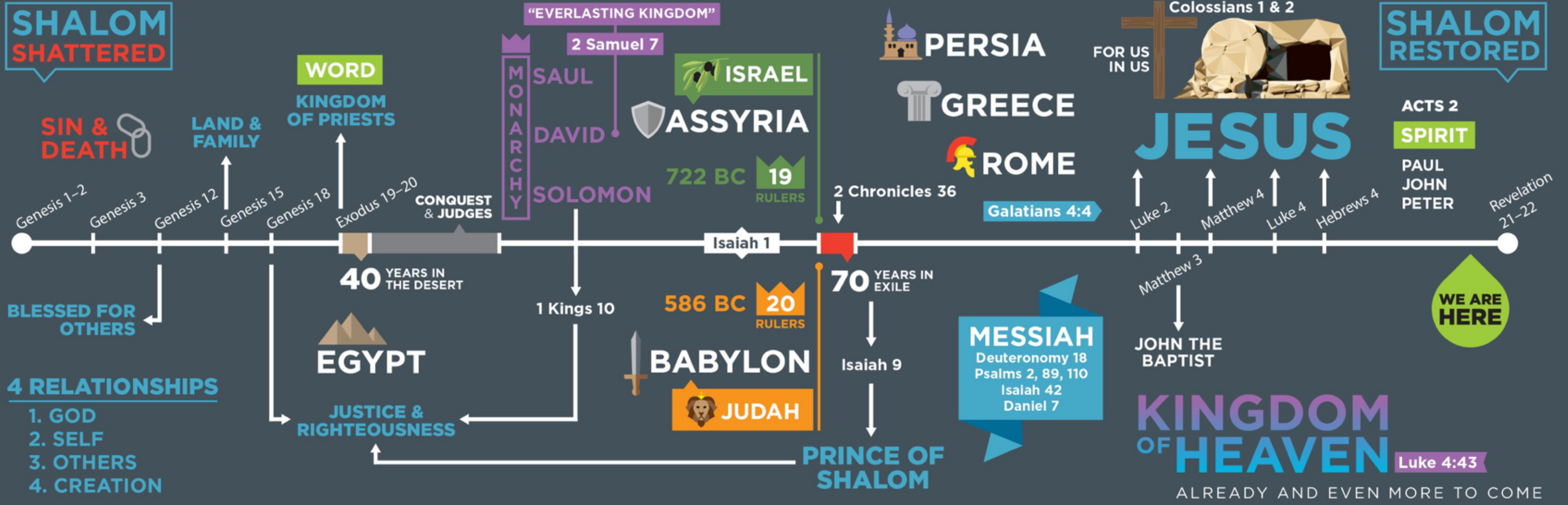
The Delay in Judgement:
