BIG IDEA:

3. Summarize the difference between Jonah's and Jesus's attitude to their toxic cities.
4. What could avoiding self-interest and embracing sacrifice for the people of our town look like for our church?
5. It was the closely knit Christian congregations that upset the ruling Roman elite to the point that they eventually outlawed private gatherings. Similar rules exist in toxic cities around the world today. What personal qualities do you think are necessary to remain faithful in such toxic environments?
6. No matter how toxic a city got, the Christian commitment to the needs of the people around them never wavered. What needs do you encounter in our city?
7. Spend time praying for the ministries Pastor Craig mentioned. Pray that our church's collective response would be blessed by God.
