1. How does Jesus's identity as Son of God influence the way you understand Jesus?
2. How does understanding Jesus's relationship with God the Father help us view God as Father?
3. How might it help us frame our understanding of ourselves as sons and daughters of God?
4. At Jesus's baptism, a voice from heaven said, "This is my Son, whom I love; with him I am well pleased" (Matt. 3:17).
In your experience do you feel loved by God?
If so, what evidence can you point to that this is the case?
If not, why do you feel that way in this season of your life?
5. Do you sense that God is well pleased with you? Why or why not?
6. Jesus says "For whoever does the will of my Father in heaven is my brother and sister and mother." What, specifically, will it mean for you to do the will of God this week?
7. Is there an area of your life where you are reluctant to act on God's leading?
8. What is at the core of your distrust or resistance?
9. Are you ready to confess it? Repent of it? And ask for courage to move forward?
