**BELONG TO ONE ANOTHER** 

**Icebreaker:** At the beginning of his message, Chris asked us to imagine ourselves at a favorite summer-time destination. Where would that be for you?

- 1. Read Luke 22:15. Interestingly enough, even Jesus showed that He desired to be "in community." In what ways do we see the Godhead giving mankind an example by entering into "community?"
- 2. In his message, Chris said, "Never have we been so connected and yet so isolated." Do you agree or disagree with that statement? If you agree, what are the factors in our society that keep us isolated from each other?
- 3. What do you believe are some common "community" busters? I.e. what causes there to be divisions among believers either in small group settings or in the broader church contexts?
- 4. What is the best way to overcome these "community busters?" What are some very practical ways we can maintain unity between brothers and sisters in Christ?
- 5. Jesus made it clear that His followers were to be people who forgave others...multiple times. How do we keep our hearts tender enough to continue to forgive instead of becoming hardened and unforgiving in nature?
- 6. A personal question that you don't have to answer in the group: Is there someone Holy Spirit is inviting you to forgive?
- 7. What is a way you could enter into community in a richer, more intentional way with others?
