5. Based on the Letter to Smyrna, identify one way that the Lord might be nudging you toward growth and change.
6. In the letter to Smyrna, the enemy is mentioned for the first time in the book of Revelation. What do we know about his schemes from the Garden of Eden (Genesis 3) and the testing of Jesus in the wilderness (Matthew 4)?
